Dear Family,

In our class, we've been reading the September 2019 issue of *SuperScience*. Look at the table of contents on page 2 and ask your child to tell you about a favorite story that we've read in class.

Here are some questions you can ask and activities you can do with the magazine to build your child's reading and thinking skills.

- **With your child, read the story "Defying Gravity," on pages 10-14.** Ask: What do you think it would be like to fly in a jet suit? Draw your child's attention to the last paragraph of the story. Ask: What idea would you like to turn into reality? Does it involve creating a new invention?



- **Together, read the story "Bricks and Beats," on pages 8-9,** about how architecture can help solve real-world problems. Talk about the issues affecting your own neighborhood or community. What can you and your child do to bring about change?



- **Turn to page 16 and observe the photo.** Help your child answer the questions below the image. Ask: What questions do you still have about the photo? Research the answers together.
